Who Are We?

The Pacific Diabetes Education Program (PDEP) is a new program of Papa Ola Lōkahi, designed to develop diabetes education materials that meet the needs of Native Hawaiians and Pacific Islanders. For the next 3 years, PDEP will be working with the Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs Health Committee to develop and revise brochures that promote diabetes awareness and education for Native Hawaiians.

How Can Your Club Get Involved?

PDEP is looking for individual Civic Clubs to test diabetes education materials. To participate, your club must meet the following criteria:

- Your club must be located in the state of Hawai'i
- Your club must identify a liaison (club member) to communicate with PDEP staff
- Your club must be able to coordinate 1 meeting (approximately 2 hours long), with at least 10 members present

Why Should Your Club Get Involved?

If your club participates in testing diabetes education materials, it will benefit from the following:

- Your club will have the opportunity to voice an opinion about diabetes education for Hawaiians
- Your club will be acknowledged for contributing to the education materials
- Your club will receive \$1000 for its general operating fund!
